



Uniform Policy

At our school, we have a distinctive purple uniform that all children are expected to wear. The uniform requirements are as follows:

Nursery

- White T-shirt
- Purple school sweatshirt
- Suitable bottoms

Key Stage 1 & Key Stage 2

- Grey trousers or skirt
- White polo shirt or white shirt (tie optional)
- Purple sweatshirt or cardigan
- Sensible flat black school shoes (not trainers)
- Headscarves need to be plain and in school colours/black white

PE Kit

- White short-sleeved t-shirt
- Black or navy jogging bottoms
- Black hoody/jumper for outdoors
- Pumps or training shoes

General Rules

- Jewellery is not permitted except for stud earrings
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted
- High-heeled shoes should not be worn for safety reasons
- All belongings must be clearly labelled with the child's name and class

The school cannot be responsible for expensive items brought to school, so please do not allow your child to bring such items.

Purchasing Uniform

- School uniform can be purchased online at www.brigade.uk.com. Non-logo uniform is allowed. This can be purchased from local supermarkets.



- Selected second hand uniform is available for free from the school office.
- Free delivery to school, or home delivery at a charge
- Items available include sweatshirts, cardigans, gingham purple summer dresses
- Book bags with shoulder straps can be purchased online.
